

## **ENPI CBC Hungary-Slovakia-Romania-Ukraine Programme**

Total allocation: 68.638 million EUR

Eligible regions:

**Hungary:** Szabolcs-Szatmár-Bereg (adjoining region: Borsod-Abaúj-Zemplén)

**Slovakia:** Košický, Prešovský

**Romania:** Maramureş, Satu-Mare (adjoining region: Suceava)

**Ukraine:** Zakarpatska, Ivano-Frankivska, (adjoining region: Chernivetska)

The participation of Suceava and Chernivetska is restricted (e.g. no Lead partner from the regions, participation in soft projects etc.)

Managing Authority: The National Development Agency in Hungary

The overall objective of the programme, as agreed by all countries participating is as follows: 'to intensify and deepen the cooperation in an environmentally, socially and economically sustainable way between Zakarpatska, Ivano-Frankivska and Chernivetska regions of Ukraine and eligible and adjacent areas of Hungary, Romania and Slovakia'.

Priorities of the programme:

- 1. Promote economic and social development:** Harmonised development of tourism; to create better conditions for SME's and business development
- 2. Enhance environmental quality:** Environmental protection, sustainable use and management of natural resources; emergency preparedness
- 3. Increase border efficiency:** Improvement of border-crossing transport infrastructure and equipment at border controls
- 4. Support people to people cooperation:** Institutional cooperation; small scale "people to people" cooperation
